Medical Assistant

- Complete administrative and clinical tasks in hospitals, offices of physicians, and other healthcare facilities.
- Work closely with a team of staff, including physicians and advanced level providers, to ensure the delivery of high-quality patient care.
- Prepares patients for their health care visit by directing and/or accompanying them to the examining room; providing examining gowns and drapes; arranging examining room instruments, supplies, and equipment.
- Assist with exams and procedures, administer medications, and perform test under the supervision of a licensed medical provider.

Requirements:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Credentialing through a nationally recognized Medical Assistant program
- Current American Heart Association Basic Life Support (AHA-BLS) for the Healthcare Provider.
