Nursing Assistant

- Provide initial patient evaluation, in accordance to physician request, in order to initiate appropriate treatment.
- Communicate with patients, physicians, nurses and other personnel regarding patient care.
- Keep therapist informed of patient response to treatment in order to adjust, plan, and update goals, reassess or discharge.

Requirements:

- Graduate of an accredited program of Occupational Therapy Assistant.
- Licensed to practice as an Occupational Therapist Assistant or within 6 months of hire.
- Current BLS – Healthcare provider (must be AHA accredited)
