Respiratory Therapists

- Assist in the diagnosis, treatment and management of patients with disorders affecting the lungs.
 - Care for newborn infants, children and adults with diseases such as asthma, emphysema and bronchitis.
 - Requirements:
 - Associates or Bachelor's Degree
 - Credentials as a Registered Respiratory Therapist
- 2022 Median Salary is \$70,540**

Nurse Midwife

- Assists women through pregnancy, childbirth and postpartum care.
 - Deliver babies in low-risk pregnancies and work closely with gynecologists to assess and diagnose chronic illnesses with pregnant women.
 - Requirements:
 - Master's degree (Master of Science in Nursing-MSN)
 - Completion of midwifery program
 - Midwifery license
- 2022 Median Salary is \$125,900**

Anesthesiologist

- Administer anesthetics and analgesics for pain management prior to, during, or after surgery or procedure.
 - Requirements:
 - Bachelor's Degree
 - Medical School
 - Residency
 - Licensure with State Medical Board
- 2022 Median Salary is \$302,970**

Obstetrician

- Obstetricians and gynecologists focus on women's health, including pregnancy, childbirth, and their overall well-being.
 - Diagnose, treat, and help prevent diseases of women, particularly those affecting the reproductive system.
 - Provide general care to women.
 - Perform both medical and gynecological surgery functions.
 - Requirements:
 - Bachelor's Degree
 - Doctorate of Medicine (M.D.)
 - OB/GYN Residency
 - Licensure with State Medical Board
- 2022 Median Salary is \$277,320**

Surgical Technologists

- Help prepare and implement a surgery by gathering tools and scrubs as well as positioning the patient.
 - Assist the surgeon with various tasks during the surgery.
 - Requirements:
 - Diploma, certificate, or Associate's Degree from an accredited surgical technology program
- 2022 Median Salary is \$55,960**

Registered Nurse

- Provide and coordinate patient care and educate patients and the public about various health conditions.
 - Responsible for all aspects of assessing, planning, providing, evaluating patient care.
 - Requirements:
 - Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)
 - State Licensure
- 2022 Median Salary is \$81,220**
