Nursing Assistant

- Takes vital signs and helps patients bathe, dress, eat, and go to activities.
- Help patients go to the bathroom and transfer from their beds to chairs.
- CNAs report to either registered nurses or licensed practical or licensed vocational nurses.

- Requirements:
 - High School Diploma or GED
 - Complete a state-approved CNA training program (Programs may be online, at a hospital, vocational school, community college, etc.)
 - Complete in-person clinical training
 - State CNA Licensure exam
