Your journey to finding your path

- Review patients' records for timeliness, completeness, and accuracy
- Organize and update information in clinical databases or registries
- Use classification systems to assign clinical codes for insurance reimbursement and data analysis
- Electronically record data for collection, storage, analysis, retrieval, and reporting
- Maintain confidentiality of patients' records

Requirements:

- Some entry level positions only require a High School Diploma or equivalent certificate, and knowledge of medical terminology
- Associate's Degree
 - Seek programs accredited by the Commission for Accreditation for Health Informatics and Information Management Education (CAHIIM).
 - Courses in these programs include topics such as medical terminology, anatomy, medical coding, statistics and database security.
 - High school courses to increase chance of admission: health, computer science, math, and biology
- Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT) Certification
