

Sterile Processing Technician Fast Facts

Your journey to finding your path

- Be responsible for the effective cleaning, inspection, maintenance, proper sterilization and distribution of sterile instrumentation and equipment.
- Work collaboratively with other departments to ensure all supplies, instrumentation, and equipment are available for surgical cases as well as other procedures requiring sterile supplies and/or instrumentation.
- Be knowledgeable in sterile processing standard and serve as a patient safety advocate.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Certified Registered Central Service Technician (CRCST) certification, or a Certified Sterile Processing and Distribution Technician (CSPDT) certification, within 18 months of hire.
- 1 year of healthcare experience, or successful completion of a sterile processing course.
