- All clinical placements, hospital & ambulatory settings, are made using the same process:
 - School of Nursing contact the PHRMH Clinical Coordinator via phone (541-387-6236) or email Davina.craig@providence.org
 - Once confirmation of availability is given via email, complete and submit the regional student requirements (student packet) in a timely way so all clearance and preparations can be made prior to your arrival.
- When on the unit, students are asked to use hallway computers for individual work rather than in nursing/LIP workstations, to avoid congestion.
- Students/instructors please coordinate with the patient's RN prior to entering patient's room.
